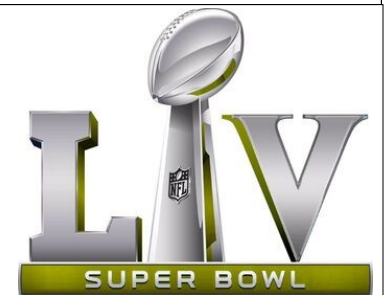

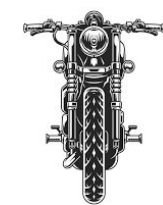

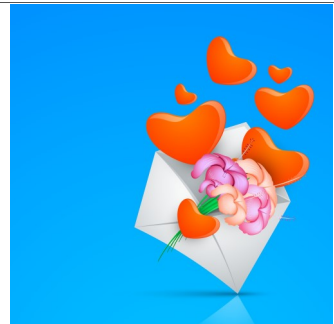

BOY SCOUT TROOP #92

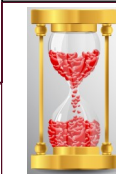
