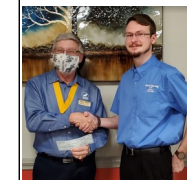

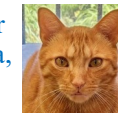

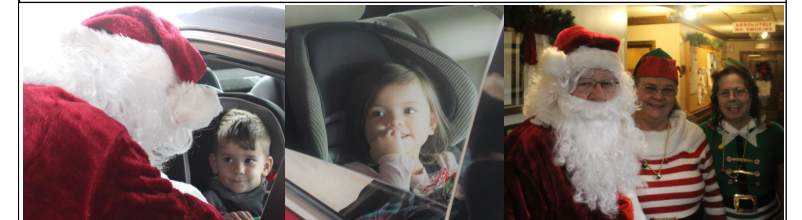
**BOY SCOUT TROOP #92**
