They are also instrumental in ensuring that two needy families in our community receive a hot meal and gifts at Thanksgiving and Christmas. These special ladies are Mary Ann Gray, Charlotte Peters, Nancy Burns and Gerrie Richard, who served as this year's Community Service Committee Chair. They truly exemplify the true essence of the Women of the Moose, giving of their time and talents. These contributions are made possible through the generous support of our LOOM/WOTM members.
