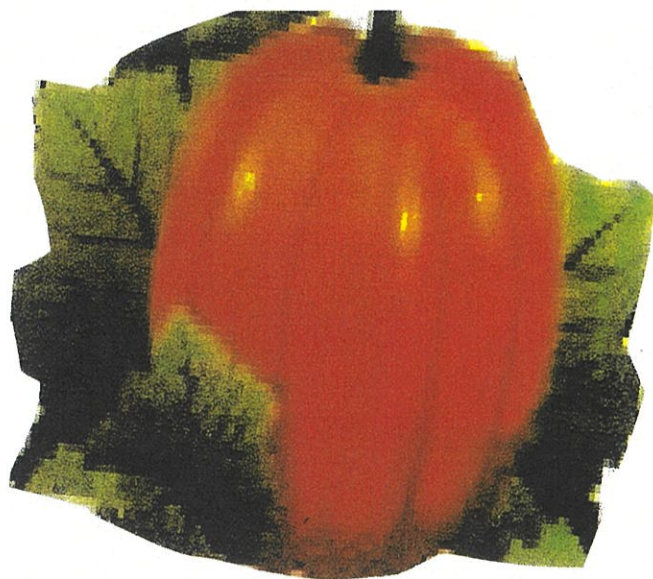

While they went off to buy it, the bridegroom came and those who were ready went into the wedding feast with him. Then the door was locked. Afterwards the other virgins came and said, "Lord, Lord, open the door for us! But he said in reply, "Amen, I say to you, I do not know you." Therefore stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour (Matt. 25: 10-13

FIRST READING The First Reading is taken from the *Book of Wisdom 6:12-16* and cites watchfulness as the key to a faithful religion and understanding of wisdom.

SECOND READING Paul had preached to them and left them with the impression that the second coming of Christ was imminent. Some died before the *paruosia* and their concern is what has happened to them. Paul states firmly and categorically that what matters is that they interpret these events because of their faith and hope in the Lord.

GOSPEL is from St. Matthew 25: 1-13. Our Lord described an incident that happened or could have happened at a wedding festival in order to bring home to his listeners the need for being everyone vigilant and ready in his service if they wish to avoid the calamity of being excluded from the heavenly and eternal nuptials on the last day. In the other parable in which our Lord uses a wedding feast to describe his kingdom, the lesson concerns those who refused the invitation and will not come to the wedding. Here it concerns those who gladly accept the invitation.

The next general meeting of Michigan City parishioners is scheduled for this Wednesday, November 15 at 6:00 p.m., at Queen of All Saints Church.

This will be the last general meeting of parishioners from our parishes.

The Key Leaders will be meeting for the last time on Wednesday, November 29, to “summarize, prioritize, and discuss new alternatives.”

Recommendations to Bishop McClory will be presented in December 2023.

It appears that this Wednesday’s meeting will be the last opportunity for the “rank and file” to express their ideas, views, and opinions. So, I encourage active parish participation.

Let Us Kneel

Bishop McClory has decided that, effective the weekend of Sunday, November 26, Solemnity of Christ the King (weekend after Thanksgiving), the churches of the Diocese of Gary will return to the practice of kneeling during the short interval between the Lamb of God and Holy Communion to bring us into conformity with the practice of other dioceses.

After receiving Holy Communion, one can choose to stand, sit, or kneel, before all sit for a few minutes of silent recollection.
