CHRIST IS OUR LIGHT
John the Baptist came to witness
to the Christ, God's light in a
dark world. This is a reason to
rejoice. We are not alone. God is
with us. His Son will soon be
here.

FIRST READING The reading from Isaiah speaks to the greatness of God. And, the greatness of his servant who carried his message. This is a time of divine favor, a time for joy.

PSALM Instead of a psalm, this Sunday's hymn is the Magnificat, the Blessed Virgin's song to God. It is a hymn of praise and a proclamation of God's mighty acts in the nation and in her life.

SECOND READING In his first letter to the Thessalonians, St. Paul wrote, "Rejoice always." This should be the hallmark of the Christian, a sense of deep joy that is infectious.

GOSPEL Last week, we met the figure of John the Baptist in Mark's gospel. This week, we turn to John's gospel to discover how the Baptist defined his role. He was not the Messiah. He was an Elijah like figure that would set the stage for the Lord's coming.

"Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and his name shall be called Emmanuel."


