**PSALM** Psalm 72 sang praise to Yahweh for a just king who would bring peace for all peoples.

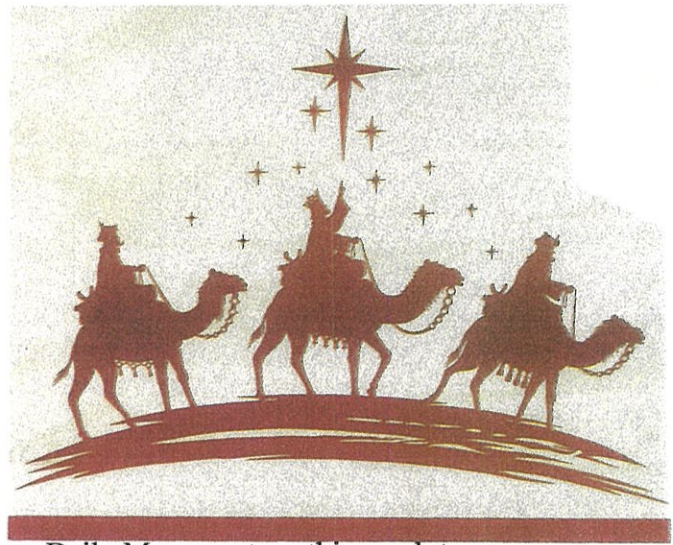
