Sunday, January 7, 2024 Revelation to the Nations

When does the local become universal? When does an event at a particular place and time mean something to everyone, especially the outcast? Hint: when the people involved reach beyond themselves to touch others. In the visit of the Magi, we see foreigners arrive to honor the new King.

FIRST READING

In Isaiah 60, the prophet encouraged a dispirited people, telling them a light would shine on them, dispersing the darkness.

PSALM Psalm 72 sang praise to Yahweh for a just king who would bring peace for all peoples.

SECOND READING In Ephesians 3, grace revealed itself as something more than the presence of God in life; it was a means of evangelization. When people see the work of grace in our lives, they see God himself.

GOSPEL In Matthew 2, the Magi sought the new King of the Jews. Like them, we seek the King; when we find him, we worship him, offering our best to him.


