Many know that parishioner Doug Noveroske has been studying and preparing to become a Permanent Deacon for the Diocese of Gary for at least four years or more.

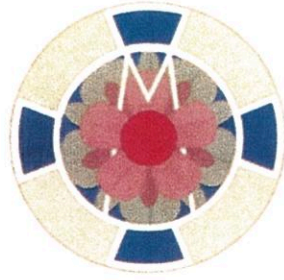
He will be ordained by Bishop McClory on Saturday, June 8, 2024 @ 10 am at the Cathedral.

TWO FEASTS

In many diocese in the United States and in many countries throughout the world, the celebrations of Easter has been shifted from ten days before Pentecost to the nearest Sunday.

FIRST READING While Jesus stayed with them, he gave them the following command: “Don’t leave Jerusalem. Instead wait here for the gift that I told you about, the one my Father promised you. Remember, John baptized you with water. But, in a few days you will be baptized with God’s Spirit.:

PSALM Oh clap your hands, all you nations. Shout to God with the voice of triumph! For Yahweh Most High is awesome. He is a great King over all the earth.

SECOND READING May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a wise spirit. May he also give you insight about who God is and what he does. May he open your heart to see what he offers you. He gives you hope when he called you to become followers of Jesus.

GOSPEL The eleven followers went to the mountain in Galilee where Jesus told them to go. When they saw Jesus they worshipped him. But, some still had doublets. When Jesus came closer, he said to them, “My Father gave me power over everything in heaven and earth. So, go. Make followers in every nation. Baptize them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

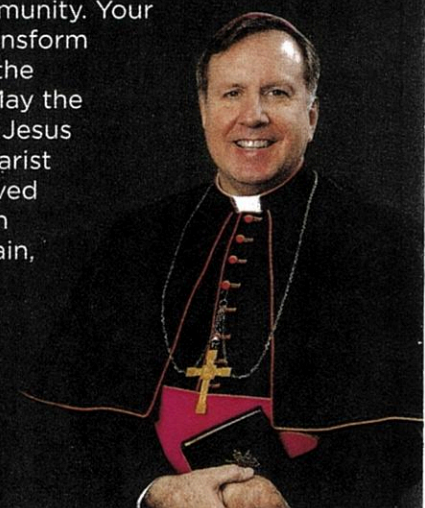
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
