**Love One Another As I Have
Loved You**

“Love makes the world go round.” While we might dispute the wisdom of that saying, we cannot deny its truth when it comes to faith. God loves us and gave his Son for us. We are to love others in the same way. This love should define our identity and mission as Christians.

FIRST READING The book of Acts presented a dilemma to St. Peter. He was to step into the house of a non-Jew and an opponent of the Jewish nation. He entered the house of Cornelius, the Roman centurion. When Peter heard and saw what God was doing in the home, opponents became friends, even brothers in the Lord.

PSALM Psalm 28 teaches us that prayer can lead to praise. And praise can become infectious.

SECOND READING If there was one word that described the God Christians worship and the Church community, that word would be “love.” 1 John 4 makes that point explicit.

GOSPEL In John’s Gospel, Jesus defined the reason for being a Christian and the true cause of evangelization in love. God loved us and sent his Son to us as a sign of that love. We are to love, in order to form community and invite others to join us.

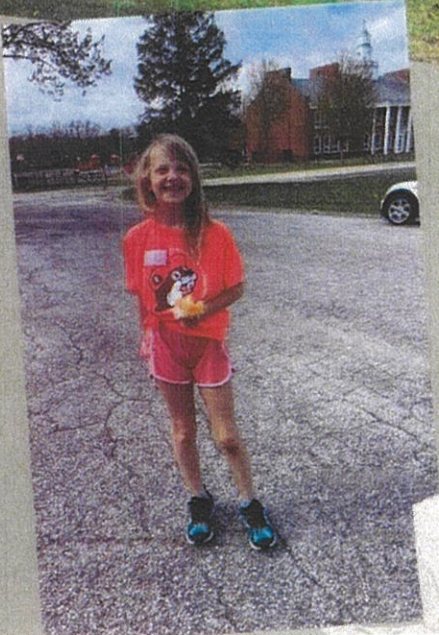

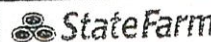
