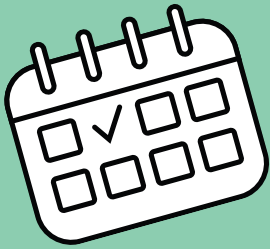

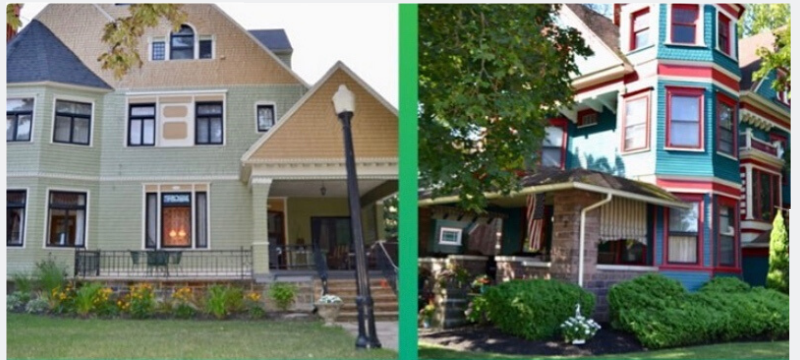

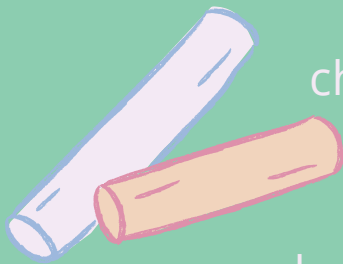
# SCAVENGER HUNT FUN

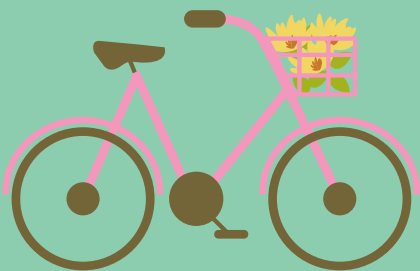
# Waving Wednesday!
