Meet The Member



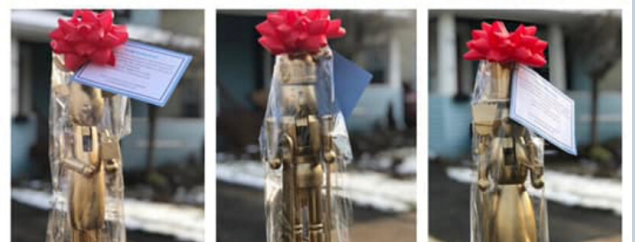

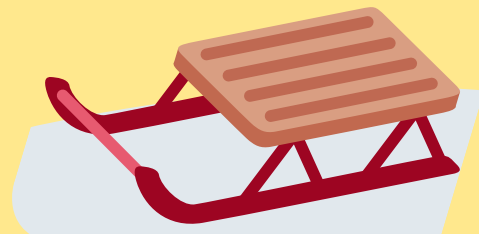
1st Annual Holiday House Decorating Contest



We had 3 Winners for our **1st annual Holiday House Decorating Contest**. You could find the winning houses on Fletcher, Rogers and Elmwood park.

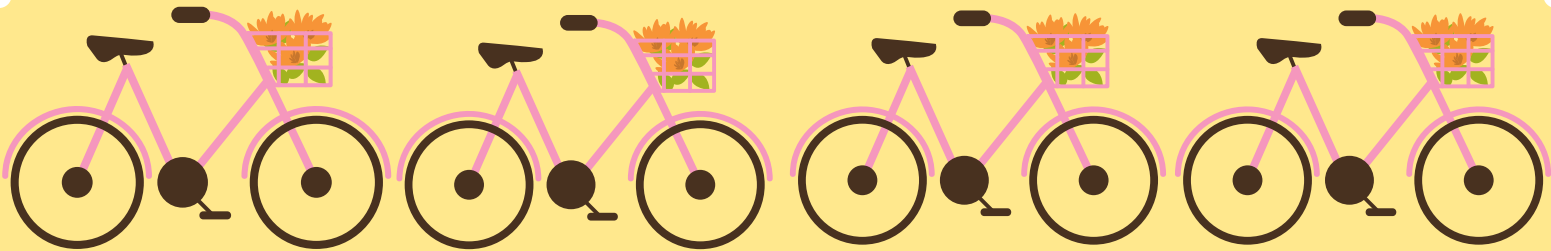
The winners received an awesome handcrafted trophy donated by a COT Neighbors United member. We look forward to next years contest. The City looked so beautiful with all the decorated homes.
