- Must have *contributed to and influenced* the education and lives of the students.

Nominations for consideration shall be submitted to the Oklahoma African American Educators Hall Fame, Inc. Nomination Committee, 110126 North 3830 Road, Clearview, Oklahoma 74880. Nominations must be postmarked no later than May 15, 2024.

INDUCTION CEREMONY:

This is the *Thirteenth Annul Oklahoma African American Educators Hall of Fame, Inc.* Induction Ceremony. It is scheduled for Friday evening, **September 27, 2024,** at the Grand Casino Event Center, 777 Grand Blvd, Shawnee, Oklahoma 74804.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Download and **type** the nomination form.
- 2. Attach a vita or resume
 - a) Educational instructions and years completed
 - b) Professional Affiliations/Professional Experiences
 - c) Community involvement
 - d) Honors/Awards/Special Recognitions
- 3. Submit a biographical sketch of the nominee's early life leading up to his or her educational career including parents, siblings, schools attended, etc. (no more than two pages)
- 4. Submit **one nomination** letter from person making nomination detailing the following:
 - a. Evidence that this nominee has exemplified him/herself as a role model to students, colleagues, parents, and community leaders.
 - b. Evidence that this nominee has demonstrated a passion for education and student success.
 - c. Evident that this nominee has demonstrated the pursuit of knowledge through the obtaining of additional hours, certificates, or degrees.
 - d. Evidence of **professional and community involvement**.
 - e. Evidence of awards or special recognition.
- 5. Submit letters **two** supporting letters of recommendations from colleague, friend, family, student.
- 6. Submit **one professional 8x10 black and white photo** of the nominee. Photo will not be returned.
- 7. In addition, if selected, inductee or representative will be required to complete a 45- minute video interview during the month of June 2024 tentatively set at the Oklahoma History Center.
