Veterans Perspective: Long Term Care offers introductory sessions to understanding Medicaid, Medicare, Tricare, VA Benefits, Private Insurance, and understanding out-of-pocket costs.

Wealth Management, Elder Law, and Aging Services presentations on Hospice, Area Agencies on Aging, and more are available, but **must be scheduled in advance.**  Veteran support networks are available to help navigate benefits, claims, and insurance plans. Thorough documentation and knowing what agencies are responsible for processing information are crucial to getting responses.
