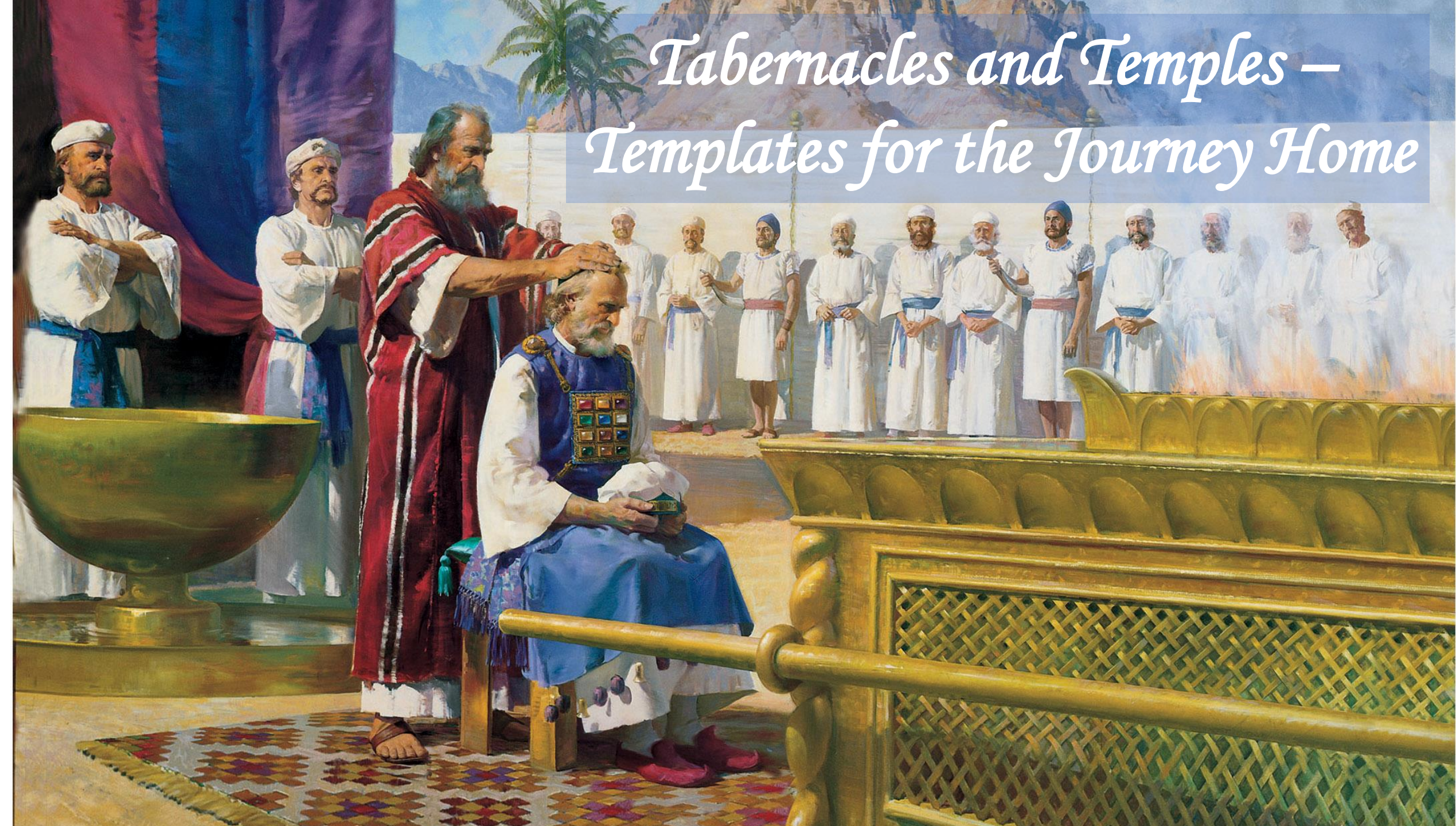
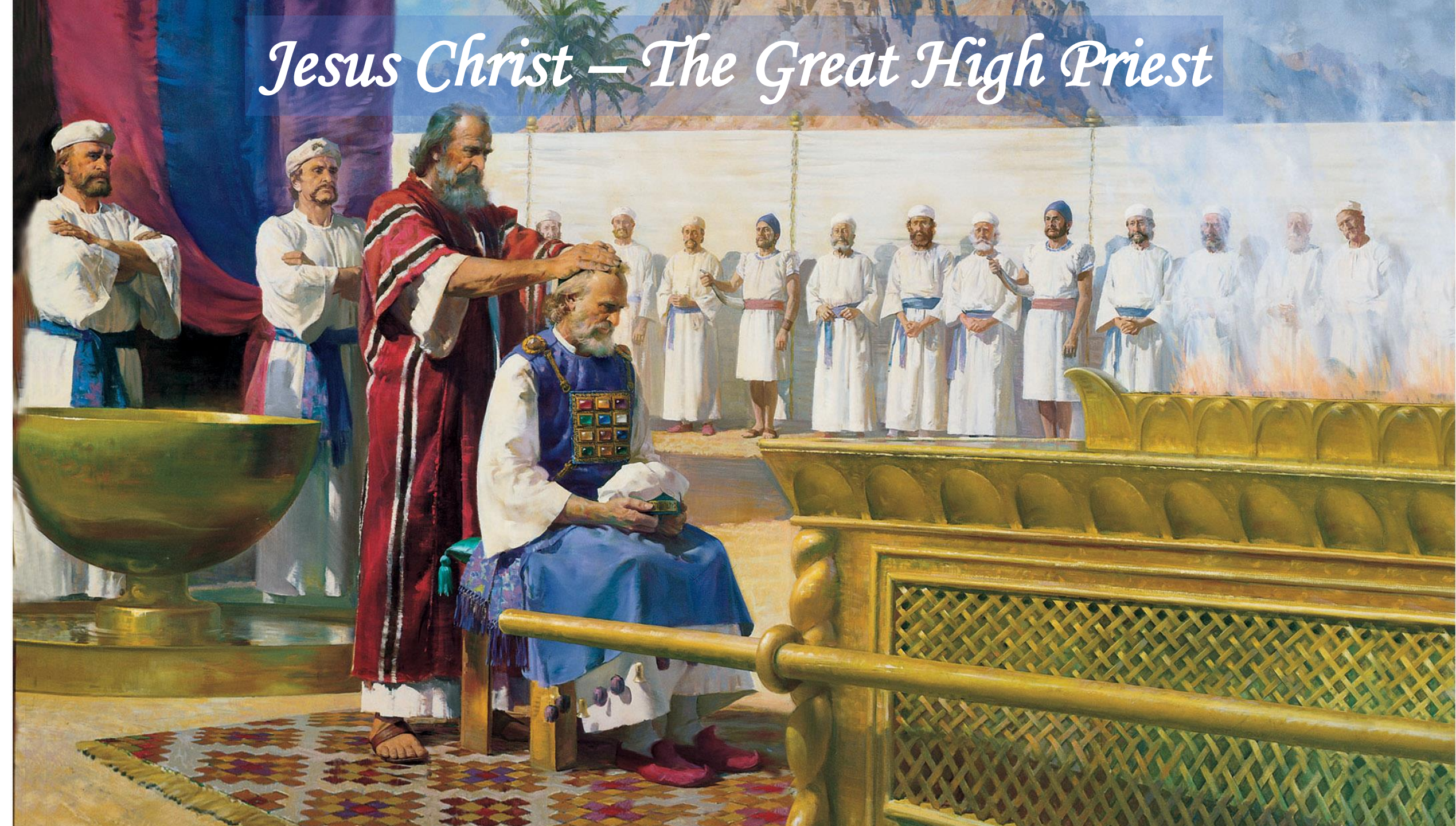



Tabernacles and Temples – Templates for the Journey Home

Though Moses had sought diligently to lead the people into the presence of the Lord, they hardened their hearts, rejected the way which the Lord had provided, and found themselves unable to pass within the Holy of Holies. The way back into God's presence and the fullness of his glory was now closed. Entrance back into God's presence required more than a tabernacle of Aaronic priesthood ordinances. It required a "high priest of good things to come" in order to open the way back home (see **Hebrews 9:11-12**).
