I. **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to define the minimum qualifications for a candidate for the Tarrant County Emergency Nurses Association (TCENA) Board of Directors.

A. President-Elect

1. Candidate must be a voting member in good standing in the national, Texas, and Tarrant County Chapter of Emergency Nurses Association.
2. Candidate must have current Registered Nurse (RN) license in Texas.
3. Candidate must have attended at least 3 TCENA chapter meetings in the past rolling twelve (12) months and meet one of the following:
 - a. Served on the TCENA Board of Directors in the past 2 years.
 - b. Served on a TCENA committee or workgroup in the past 2 years.
 - c. Served as a TCENA delegate to the Texas General Assembly in the past year.
4. New members to TCENA, that transferred membership from a different chapter and meet the requirements above, can be an eligible candidate.

B. All other TCENA Board of Director positions

1. Candidate must be a voting member in good standing in the national, Texas, and Tarrant County Chapter of Emergency Nurses Association.
2. Candidate must have current Registered Nurse (RN) license in Texas.
3. Treasurer must have served six (6) months as Treasurer-Elect with mentorship from current term Treasurer.
