

- Bettendorf stunned #3-ranked Cedar Rapids Washington 27-25 during Week #3 of the season
- Brian Speidel earned *Times-Democrat* "Prep Player of the Week" during the season
- Bettendorf earned a final ranking of #7 by the *Des Moines Register*, #8 by the *U.P.I.*, and #9 by the *A.P.*
- Head Coach Ray Oles named as M.V.C.'s "Coach of the Year"
