

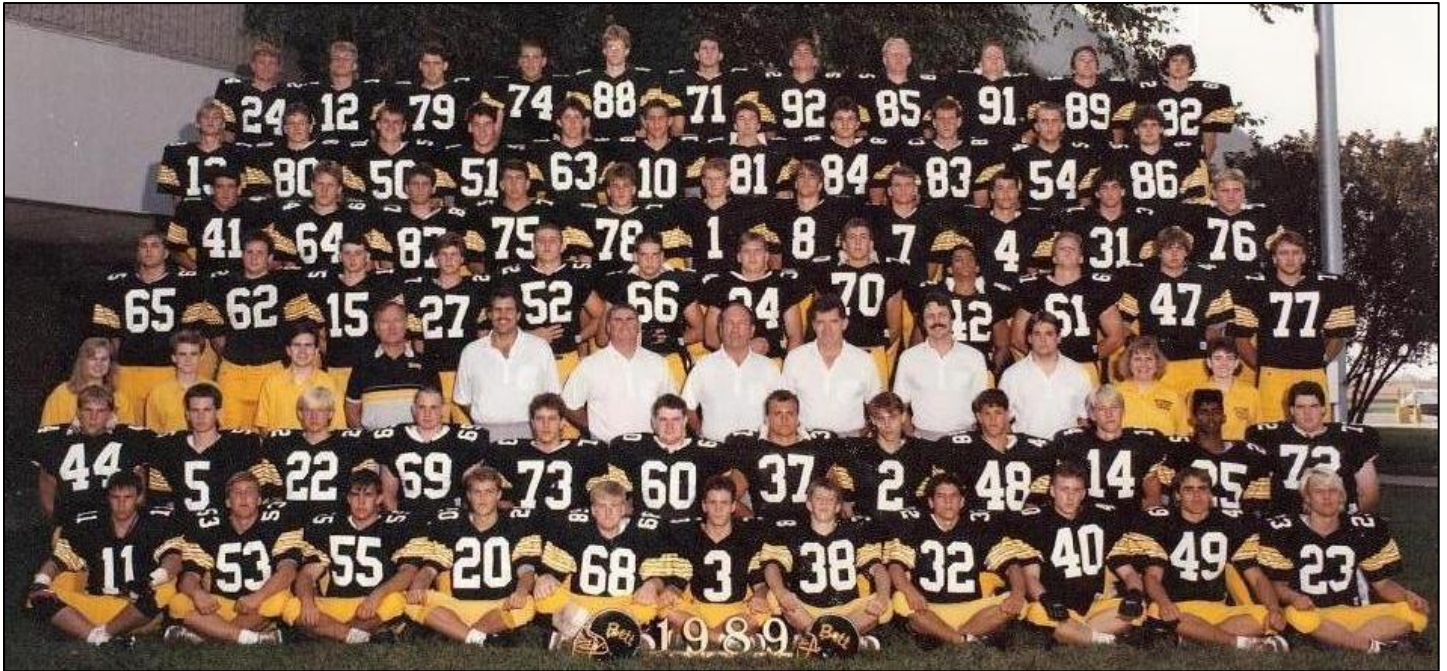

- #1-ranked Bettendorf (8-0) defeated #3-ranked Burlington (8-0) in Week #9 for the M.A.C. Championship
- The Bulldogs were an "Honorable Mention: Team to Watch" by *USA Today*
- The 1989 squad extended Bettendorf's winning streak from 25-wins to 36-straight games
- Bulldog defense only allowed five (5) 1st Half touchdowns the entire season including playoffs
- 3rd consecutive year in MAC without a loss (26-straight wins)
- Merv Habenicht named as "MAC Coach of the Year"
- Athletic Trainer Reggie Speak earned "Distinguished Service Award" by the Iowa Football Coaches Association
