

Reglazing Proper Care and Maintenance

- Allow finish to cure (at room temperature) for a minimum of 24 hours before usage. The full cure time is 7 days. During this time period, avoid cleaning and working in and around the tub.
- Use non-abrasive cleaners only, such as Lysol Bathroom Cleaner or SC Johnson Bathroom Cleaner (aka Scrubbing Bubbles). Use a soft sponge only. Using these products will help maintain your bathtub's glossy finish.
- Check your plumbing periodically. Damage caused by a constant drip or leak is not covered under our guarantee. If any plumbing work is needed, cover the floor of the tub with a heavy blanket or drop cloth.
- NEVER use bathmats with suction cups or stick-on appliques. A non-slip application can be applied to your tub floor for safety.
- NEVER apply ANY tape to the reglazed surface. Peeling due to removal of tape is not covered under our guarantee.
- Avoid leaving shampoo bottles in the corners of your tub and tiles.
- Drying your bathtub with a ALL plastic squeegee or shammy after every use will prolong the life of the finish. This will also make cleaning easier/less frequent.
- ONLY use an ALL-PLASTIC squeegee with no metal parts at all. Metal squeegees can cause chips and scratches to the finish.
