Construction of this vaudeville silent movie house began in 1920. Financial failure halted construction on the Electric Theater with the outside walls only partially completed. Purchased by Claude Keller and A.F. McGee Sr., the theater was completed and opened July 19, 1924 as the New Liberty Theatre.





# C hristmas<sub>TR</sub>

**Man In Red** Father Christmas is based on a real person, St. Nicholas, which explains his other name 'Santa Claus' which comes from the Dutch 'Sinterklaas'. Nicholas was a Christian

leader from Myra (in modern-day Turkey) in the 4th century AD. He was very shy, and wanted to give money to poor people without them knowing about it. It is said that one day, he climbed the roof of a house and dropped a purse of money down the chimney. It landed in the stocking which a girl had put to dry by the fire! This may explain the belief that Father Christmas comes down the chimney and places gifts in children's stockings.

### Mistletoe and Holly

Two hundred years before the birth of Christ, the Druids used mistletoe to celebrate the coming of winter. They would gather this evergreen plant and use it to decorate their homes. They believed the plant had special healing powers for everything from female infertility to poison ingestion. Scandinavians also thought of mistletoe as a plant of peace and harmony. They associated mistletoe with their goddess of love, Frigga. The custom of kissing under the mistletoe probably derived from this belief.

### The Christmas Tree

The Christmas Tree originated in Germany in the 16th century. It was common for the Germanic people to decorate fir trees, both inside and out, with roses, apples, and colored paper. It is believed that Martin Luther, the Protestant reformer, was the first to light a Christmas tree with candles. Struck by the beauty of the starlight shining through the branches of a small fir tree outside his home he duplicated the starlight by using candles attached to the branches of his indoor Christmas tree. The Christmas tree was brought to America by the Pennsylvania Germans in the 1820's.

ABOUT Ohristmas

- •Electric tree lights were first used just 3 years after Thomas Edison had his first mass public demonstration of electric lights back in 1879. Edison's assistant. Edward Johnson, came up with the idea of electric lights for Christmas trees in 1882. His lights were a huge hit. It took quite a few years, however, before they would be made available to the general public.
- ◆The turkey was imported to France by the Jesuits and it is still known in some French dialects as a 'Jesuite'.
- December 25th was not celebrated as the birthday of Christ until the year AD 440.
- St. Francis of Assisi introduced Christmas carols to formal church services. The first Christmas stamp was released in Canada in 1898.


