GREAT SEAL of the United States

Before it adjourned on July 4, 1776, the Continental Congress of the newly independent United States passed a resolution: Resolved, that Dr. Franklin, Mr. J. Adams and Mr. Jefferson, be a committee, to bring in a device for a seal for the United States of America. Thus, three of the five men who had drafted the Declaration of Independence were brought together in further service to their country. The revolutionaries needed an emblem and national coat of arms to give visible evidence of a sovereign nation and a free people with high aspirations and grand hopes for the future. The task proved far more difficult than anticipated; it took six years, two more committees, and the combined efforts of 14 men before the Great Seal of the United States became a reality on June 20, 1782.

New Orleans' beloved Saenger Theatre reopens Fall 2013 following a \$51 million restoration!

The opulent and historic theatre was among the many victims of Hurricane Katrina in 2005.

Although it was built to house live events, the Saenger's backstage area became undersized over time -- too small for many complex megaproductions, like *The Lion King*. The theater's rear wall was pushed back, creating a new, larger stage house to accommodate modern touring companies.

The 2,700-seat theater has acquired one of its flanking properties and will use that space for additional amenities.

The building is now owned by the city, through the Canal Street Development Corp. The Arts Center Enterprises, New Orleans -- the same company that manages the Mahalia Jackson Theatre for the Performing Arts

-- has a 52-year management contract at the Saenger. We have noted several of the scheduled performing arts opportunities at the Saenger (opposing page).

The organization is open to anyone who enjoys and appreciates vocal and instrumental music. There are no auditions or dues. We depend solely on the contributions of merchants and individuals and provide two concerts each year, July and December. The organization is operated by volunteers and pays no salaries.

In the last twenty-three years the band and choir has produced forty-six concerts. Also during these twenty-three years, we have provided music for: Eunice July Fourth celebrations, LSUE commencement exercises, city inaugurations, Eunice Centennial Celebration (performing an original work by Dr. Quincy Hilliard, ASCAP, commissioned by the ECCBC for the celebration), LSUE community fun days, Eunice Christmas celebrations, and presented concerts in Crowley, Oakdale, Ville Platte, Lafayette and New Iberia. Several members of the community choir participated in a concert at Carnegie Hall in New York City in 1994. Joining sing-

This particular logo was selected because of its simplicity and because the ECCBC is determined to move forward into the future with the mission of sharing the gift of music with the residents of Acadiana.






THE *Riberty* Center

Construction of this vaudeville silent movie house began in 1920. Financial failure halted construction on the *Electric Theater* with the outside walls only partially completed. Purchased by Claude Keller and A.F. McGee Sr., the theater was completed and opened July 19, 1924 as the New Liberty Theatre.

This *Premier Temple of Amusement*, is listed on the National Register of Historic Places by the United States Department of the Interior and has been included in the <u>National Trust</u> <u>Guide of Great American Movie</u> <u>Theaters Preservation Press Guide</u> published by the Smithsonian.
