

John Williams was born in New York City on February 8, 1932. Williams—who studied at Juilliard—worked as a jazz pianist and studio musician before starting to compose for television and film. His career took off in the 1970s. Since then, he has scored more than 100 films, including Jaws (1975), the Star Wars films, E.T. (1982) and Schindler's List (1993). Williams has won five Academy Awards and received a record-breaking array of nominations.

As of 2015, Williams has had 49 Academy Award nominations, making him the living person with the most nominations. He has won five Academy Awards. In addition

to Fiddler on the Roof, Williams received Oscars for Jaws, Star Wars (1977), E.T. and Schindler's List. Williams has also received three Emmy Awards and more than 20 Grammy Awards. In 2004, he was a Kennedy Center honoree and was given a National Medal of Arts in 2009. Golden Rules for Ensemble Singing

- 1. Everyone should sing the same piece.
- 2. Take your time turning pages.
- 3. Do not worry if you do not have perfect pitch you may find singing less stressful without it!
- 4. The right note at the wrong time is the wrong note.
- 5. The wrong note at the right time is still a wrong note.
- 6. A wrong note sung timidly is still a wrong note.
- 7. A wrong note sung with authority is an interpretation.
- 8. A true interpretation is realized when not one note of the original remains.
- 9. If you happen to sing a wrong note, give a nasty look to one of your neighbors.
- 10. If everyone gets lost except you, follow those who get lost.
- 11. If you are completely lost, stop everyone and start an argument about repeat marks.
- 12. Strive to achieve the maximum notes per second that way you at least gain the admiration of the totally incompetent.
- 13. If a passage is difficult, slow it down. If it is easy, speed it up. Everything will work itself out in the end.
- 14. Markings for slurs, dynamics, ornaments and breathing should be ignored. They are only there to embellish the score.
- 15. When everyone else has finished singing, you should not sing any notes you may still have left.

THE Organization Established in 1990

The Eunice Community Concert Band & Choir, Inc. was organized in February of 1990 with the intent to promote vocal and instrumental music in Eunice and the surrounding area. The organization is open to anyone who enjoys and appreciates vocal and instrumental music. There are no auditions or dues. We depend solely on the contributions of merchants and individuals and provide two concerts each year, July and December. The organization is operated by volunteers and pays no salaries.

In the last twenty-six years the band and choir has produced fifty concerts. Also during these twenty-six years, we have provided music for: Eunice July Fourth celebrations, LSUE commencement exercises, city inaugurations, Eunice Centennial Celebration (performing an original work by Dr. Quincy Hilliard, ASCAP, commissioned by the ECCBC for the celebration), LSUE community fun days, Eunice Christmas celebrations, and presented concerts in Crowley, Oakdale, Ville Platte, Lafayette and New Iberia. Several members of the community choir participated in a concert at Carnegie Hall in New York City in 1994. Joining singers from across the country, the group was

directed by Dr. James Haygood and worldrenowned choral conductor John Rutter.

The ECCBC has enjoyed much success since 1990. Membership in the organization has grown to over 180. For any given concert there may be as few as forty or as many as eighty of those members performing on stage. For many, the rehearsal season provides a wholesome social activity and an opportunity to meet new friends.

The organization adds to the uniqueness of this city. *Very few* American cities the size of Eunice have a musical organization such as the ECCBC. We are proud of all that we have done and look forward to serving the Eunice area with quality, family programs for many years to come. ##





LIBERTY CENTER

Construction of this vaudeville silent movie house began in 1920. Financial failure halted construction on the *Electric Theater* with the outside walls only partially completed. Purchased by Claude Keller and A.F. McGee Sr., the theater was completed and opened July 19, 1924 as the New Liberty Theatre.

This Premier Temple of Amusement, is listed on the National Register of Historic Places by the United States Department of the Interior and has been included in the National Trust Guide of Great American Movie Theaters Preservation Press Guide published by the Smithsonian.


