



The Eunice Community Concert Band & Choir, Inc. was organized in February of 1990 with the intent to promote vocal and instrumental music in Eunice and the surrounding area. The organization is open to anyone who enjoys and appreciates vocal and instrumental music. There are no auditions or dues. We depend solely on the contributions of merchants and individuals and provide two concerts each year, July and December. The organization is operated by volunteers and pays no salaries.

In the last twenty-eight years the band and choir has produced fifty-six concerts. Also during these twenty-eight years, we have provided music for: Eunice July Fourth celebrations, LSUE commencement exercises, city inaugurations, Eunice Centennial Celebration (performing an original work by Dr. Quincy Hilliard, ASCAP, commissioned by the ECCBC for the celebration), LSUE community fun days, Eunice Christmas celebrations, and presented concerts in Crowley, Oakdale, Ville Platte, Lafayette and New Iberia. Several members of the community choir participated in a concert at Carnegie Hall in New York City in 1994. Joining singers from across the country, the group was directed by Dr. James Haygood and worldrenowned choral conductor John Rutter.

The ECCBC has enjoyed much success since 1990. Membership in the organization has grown to over 180. For any given concert there may be as few as forty or as many as eighty of those members performing on stage. For many, the rehearsal season provides a wholesome social activity and an opportunity to meet new friends.

The organization adds to the uniqueness of this city. *Very few* American cities the size of Eunice have a musical organization such as the ECCBC. We are proud of all that we have done and look forward to serving the Eunice area with quality, family programs for many years to come. **#**

# OUR LOGO

In 1992, the ECCBC commissioned the University of Louisiana at Lafayette art department to create a logo for the organization. After a meeting with Dwight Jodon, Pat Dossman and the department, approximately fifteen art students set about the task of designing an appropriate ensignia.

Several of the proposed designs centered around the organization's acronymn, ECCBC. However, the winning design was a simple graphic. It symbolizes the semicircle staging used by musical ensembles globally. The image is one *in motion* as the conductor's baton sweeps across the design. This particular logo was selected because of its simplicity and because the ECCBC is determined to move forward into the future with the mission of sharing the gift of music with the residents of Acadiana.

We are proud to celebrate our twenty-eighth birthday this year, and are excited about our future. It is our desire that this logo become...*a mark of excellence!*






### LIBERTY CENTER

Construction of this vaudeville silent movie house began in 1920. Financial failure halted construction on the *Electric Theater* with the outside walls only partially completed. Purchased by Claude Keller and A.F. McGee Sr., the theater was completed and opened July 19, 1924 as the New Liberty Theatre.

This *Premier Temple of Amusement*, is listed on the National Register of Historic Places by the United States Department of the Interior and has been included in the <u>National Trust</u> <u>Guide of Great American Movie</u> <u>Theaters Preservation Press Guide</u> published by the Smithsonian.





## BUGLER'S HOLIDAY

We are thrilled to present **BUGLER'S HOLIDAY** tonight, featuring a trumpet trio: Robin Daigle, Joseph Stemplewski & Dwight Jodon. We hope you enjoy this spirited and cheerful rendition by the American master of light orchestral music, Leroy Anderson.

ROBIN A. DAIGLE Robin A. Daigle is a native of Thibodaux, La, and a graduate of Thibodaux High School. She received the Bachelor of Music Education Degree from the University of Southwestern Louisiana in 1981 and recently retired after serving 34 years in the field of music education. Ms. Daigle taught band at Eunice High School, Lafayette Middle School and Edgar Martin Middle School. At Edgar Martin, where she finished her teaching career, there were over 400 students enrolled in the band program. Throughout her teaching career, Ms. Daigle's symphonic and jazz bands competed in and out of state and consistently received superior ratings at Louisiana district and state band festivals.

Ms. Daigle has been named Phi Beta Mu Band Director of the Year, Louisiana Bandmasters Association Bandmaster of the Year, Lafayette Parish Teacher of the Year Semi-Finalist, and an LEF Teacher of the Year nominee.

Ms. Daigle spent her final years in education as the music instructional coach for the Lafayette Parish music teachers. She continues to serve as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the state and is director of the Lafayette Music Summer Band Camp. Ms. Daigle has served on various state and national music committees and has co-authored a handbook for new instrumental music teachers just entering the field of music education.

Ms. Daigle has held board positions for several professional organizations including LMEA, where she was District 3 Director, and Southwest Louisiana Band Directors' Association where she held the position of President for over 6 years. In Nov 2018, Ms. Daigle will be inducted into the LA Music Educators Association Hall of Fame.


JOSEPH STEMPLEWSKI Joe Stemplewski grew up in the New Orleans area and is a graduate of Central Lafourche High School and the University of Southwestern Louisiana. He has enjoyed a career in music education that has spanned 45 years plus. During this time he has tried to share his love of music with his students at every venture, beginning with his high school band director years and later as a talented music teacher. In the first 30 years of his career, Joe was the band director at the newly consolidated North Vermilion High School, where he began and grew a band program for the first 10 years of its existence.

From there, he touched the lives of many high school students at Crowley High, Rayne High, lota High, and Eunice High where he continued to grow and encourage these band programs to achieve their full potential.

During the next 15 years of his career, Joe decided to begin a new venture as a talented and gifted music teacher in both Vermilion and Acadia parishes. With these students, who already had a love of music, Joe finds ways to expand their horizons. Each of his students comes with a unique interest, ranging from accordion, guitar, drums, keyboard, choral, brass and wood-winds. On different occasions Joe has been able to bring these students from both parishes and showcase them at events such as the meeting of the state personnel directors, Acadia Parish Educator of the Year banquets, as well as performances at their respective schools, and other schools in the area.

Along the way, Joe found time to begin playing with the Eunice Community Concert Band where he has enjoyed meeting and playing with his fellow musicians and friends for the past 25 plus years.

Throughout it all, Joe has had the full support of his family, beginning with his wife Linda, and children, Gretchen and Joshua. And his and their love of music continues on in his grandchildren as well.
