# COVID19 ILLNESS PROTOCOL

## • PreVisit Health Check

- Santa and his helpers will sanitize their hands between each visitor interaction.

## CONTACTLESS GREETINGS

Santa and his helpers will practice contactless greetings, such as waving and verbal greetings, instead of physical contact.

## Reservations and Crowd Control

- To manage the number of visitors, reservations may be required to visit Santa.
