persons participating in these proceedings.

THE COURTROOM OR HEARING ROOM AND/OR MAY BE SUBJECT TO FINES OR

OTHER SANCTIONS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, HAVING THEIR

HEARING POSTPONED.
