Jan. 22, 2024, CPCNH will send out enrollment letters. Jan. 29, 2024, there will be a public information meeting at which a representative from CPCNH will attend to answer any questions people may have. There is an Ambassador Program that is designed to help towns new to process. Mark is an ambassador.
