Minutes of the Westmoreland Selectmen's Meeting Tuesday, November 6, 2018

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Clayton Stalker, Russ Austin and Frank Reeder

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 9:04am by Chairman Clayton Stalker.
- 2. Road Agent David Poklemba had asked for a meeting to discuss the possibility of purchasing a leaf blower that could be attached to the tractor for cleaning out ditches on gravel roads. The leaves would be blown into the woods and areas with groomed lawns would not be done. Using the leaf blower would be more efficient that using the large pieces of equipment the highway has been using. The cost of the blower is \$5,200 and funds would come from the Highway Budget. The Selectmen approved the purchase of the leaf blower.
- 3. The Selectmen signed a Recommital Warrant for the Tax Collector for 2018 taxes that are due as of September 1st when Tax Collector Cindi Adler left the position as of August 31, 2018. A Recommital Warrant for prior years is not ready to be processed.
- 4. The Selectmen signed a Warrant for the 2nd half of the 2018 property taxes. Bills will be going out by the end of the week and will be due December 15, 2018. Tax Collector Melissa Bonito is currently getting training to use the Avitar tax software that the town purchased in 2010.
- 5. The meeting was adjourned at 9:30am.
