
No action was taken on necessary 2022-2023 budget amendments pursuant to items listed on the current agenda.


Chief Miguel Cantu gave the City of Nixon police department report.




Motion was made by Maggie Gaytan and seconded by Justin La Fleur to adjourn. Motion carried 5-0


