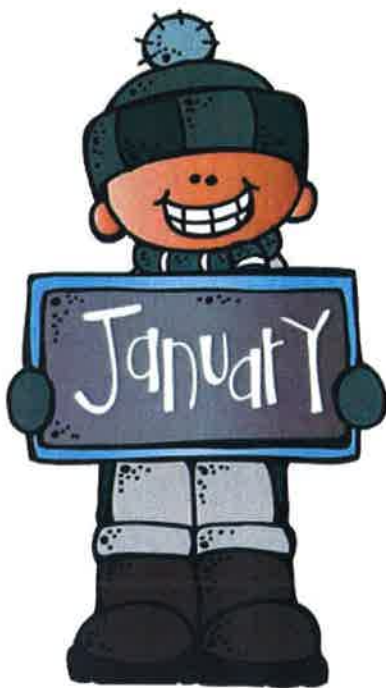

How to Register for WebFez:
