Health Programme:

We are working for the financially constraints and the poor households surrounding us. They are deprived of medical treatment and health care often. Absence of qualified Doctors create difficulties besides cost of treatment beyond the reach of the poor people.

In this context, we have organized health check up camps at different areas for the general public specially women and children. Qualified team of Doctors in various field have extended their services as also they aware the people about common and communicable diseases.

Social Programme:-

Any of a variety of governmental programs designed to protect citizens from the economic risks and insecurities of life. The most common types of programs provide benefits to the elderly or retired, the sick or invalid, dependent survivors, mothers,

the unemployed, the work-injured, and families. Methods of financing and administration and the scope of coverage and benefits vary widely among countries.

are some of the programmes **SHREE SHREE KRISHNA KALI ASHRAM** has undertaken as mass social welfare programme. These provide benefits to those who live beyond their ability or eligibility to engage in gainful employment, to those who become permanently disabled other than through work injuries and who are not covered under some other medical disability program, and to those who are left dependent by a deceased worker. Programs of this type usually provide for universal coverage; they are commonly funded as contributory insurance programs. Time-lock provisions apply to old-age benefits and, less stringently, to invalidity and survivor benefits. Benefits levels are typically 30 to 60 percent of base wages.
