JESUS IS THE GOOD SHEPERD

On the fourth Sunday of Easter, the good news is always taken from the 10th chapter of St. John where Jesus speaks of himself as the "good shepherd." Jesus presents himself as the good, the utterly dedicated shepherd who is ready to lay down his life for the sake of his sheep: "I will lay down my life for the sheep." A good shepherd is someone who takes good care of the sheep. Of course, if he is the owner, he will give extra care to his sheepfold. Jesus, as the Good Shepherd, takes good care of his sheep and practically takes them as his own; he is not a hireling. Because of this, he is willing to sacrifice for his sheep. He is not only the Good Shepherd but the best of shepherds. With Jesus as our shepherd, we are in good hands!

This task of shepherding is shared by Jesus primarily with Peter, as he said to him: "Tend my sheep, feed my lambs, and feed my sheep." This brings us to the task of praying for our Pope and all the Church's shepherds; bishops and priests whom we even call pastors and fathers.

Jesus also said: "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also must I lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd." His desire is the unity of all in him. However, this is not yet a reality today. Even Christians themselves are not united. So, let us continue to pray and work for the unity of all Christians. Lest we forget, there are sheep that do not belong to Christ's sheepfold; it means that mission and evangelization must continue. We are always in need of missionaries. Our parish as a sheepfold of Jesus is also at the frontline for missionary activities and as such, all of us are called to this mission and work of evangelization. It challenges one to ask the question: Am I involved in the evangelical work in my parish? If not, why not? There are many ways to participate and become engaged in bringing the caring hands of Jesus, our Good Shepherd to the people of our parish, to the oppressed, the outcast, the despised, the marginalized, the underdog, the weak, and the ignorant. As a Good Sheperd, Jesus' chief concern is to protect, tend, and care for his
