Mustang Drivers Club Rules 2024

v. 1.0

This document is a simple outline of the series and will be revised on an ad hoc basis.

MDC Pro Class Specific Rules

<u>General</u>

For any single event, there is a 15-car class limit. This is a first-come, first served selection based solely on drivers who register for the event. Registration for MDC Pro includes a \$25 entry fee, the proceeds of which go entirely to the series.

Class Eligibility

All MDC Pro Drivers must be must be advanced group (open passing) level, and drivers must have a demonstrated track record in the series historically, or provide information allowing for evaluation. Generally speaking, these would be drivers who have placed in the top half of legacy MDC1 or MDC2 events, or would place within the top 15 MDC Pro expected results. If you are registering for an event and wish to compete in MDC Pro but unsure of your status, please select the option for MDC Pro and we will evaluate before charging any fees.

MDC Pro Racers in 15th position or lower are at risk of losing MDC Pro Status to MDC Club Racers who request to upgrade to MDC Pro . Once bumped down to Club Racer, they will not be eligible to request upgrade back to MDC Pro for 2 Events and their performance must be better than 15th Place based on the handicap for the last 2 events. They will, however, retain any points earned up until that point. Racers Bumped down to Club Racer will complete the day in Club Racer, no refunds will be issued however.

MDC Pro Season Championship

The Series has guaranteed \$10,000 Dollars in Championship Payouts to the top 8 drivers, to be awarded at season end. Drivers must attend 5 or more events to be eligible for the purse. The Championship Payout is as follows:

1 st : \$4,000	2 nd : \$2,000	3 rd : \$1,500	4 th : \$1,000
5 th : \$750	6 th : \$500	7 th : 250	8 th : 100

A running total of points will be maintained after every event, and drivers' best of 6 out of 8 events will count toward the Championship. Starting in Round 7, drivers' lowest scoring event will be dropped from the total. Note: for MDC Pro, only the Top 10 finishers for any event will record points for that event.

Points will be scored in the following manner:

1 st : 20	2 nd : 18	3 rd : 16	4 th : 14	5 th : 13
6 th : 12	7 th : 11	8 th : 10	9 th : 9	10 th : 8

Rules Applicable to All Drivers

Completed competition forms are required before the first session of the event. These are made available online on the Facebook Group and at <u>www.mdcracers.com</u>. They may be completed and sent to <u>info@speedventures.com</u>. Alternatively, there will be paper copies at every event that can be submitted to Speed Ventures registration. Please note: this is an absolute requirement regardless if there are changes or not.

Sessions 1, 2, and 3 will count towards the competition. Where the event is held over 2 days, either single day will count. Should a driver drive both days, only the first day will count. Single event awards will be held in the afternoon of each event for both classes.

All rules of the track event will apply to MDC drivers. In addition, if any driver is found to be blocking and not facilitating passing for faster cars, whether competing in MDC or not, they will be disqualified for the day.

All cars are subject to ad hoc scrutineering. For driver-led inquiries, these must be raised with Speed Ventures staff before the second session of the day. Cars not found in compliance/non-matching Competition Form will forfeit all points for that event for first infraction. Second infraction will deem competitor ineligible for remainder of season and all points will be forfeited and racer will not be eligible for any end of year payout. Appeals can be made to Speed Ventures Staff in writing via email to <u>info@speedventures.com</u> with supporting documentation. Speed Ventures will make any and all final decisions.

MDC Club Racer is the stepping stone class in 2024 for new drivers to demonstrate their fit within MDC Pro. The Top drivers in Club Racer will be eligible for upgrade to Pro upon request if performance is within the range of the 15-car MDC Pro field. If request is granted, racer will be required to pay the MDC Pro Entry Fee \$25 prior to competing. Day of event requests will be accepted AFTER the first session to establish baseline Handicap. Club Racer Class will not accrue points.
