Welcome to the 2023 Nebraska State Fair High School Rodeo. We are excited to see all of the new and returning contestants. Here is some important information to help make the process of entering the NSF a success for everyone.

- **HORSES**

- A. CVI required.
- B. No EIA(Coggins)required for“In State”horses.
- C. The Nebraska State Fair strongly recommends that **ALL** horses also be vaccinated **PRIOR** to coming to the Fair for equine influenza and within 1 to 6 months prior to the Fair for EHV.
- D. If an emerging disease is detected in Nebraska or any other state, additional requirements may be put in place.

- **CHECK IN (See attached map)**

- Main Check in will be held at JBS parking lot.
- Ropers who entered the Breakaway Sunday night will go to a secondary location. I will be in contact with those individuals.
- CHECK IN TIMES
  - **Sunday, September 3rd ~ 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm (JBS and Luebbe Lot)**
  - **Monday, September 4th ~ 7:00 am to 10:00 am (Luebbe Lot)**

- **ADMISSION/PARKING**

- Contestants will get in free
- Families will need to purchase tickets. \$5/person/day. A ticket will need to be purchased for Sunday and Monday.
- Parking Pass - \$15
  - North Grass Area (pens can be built by trailers, but please be respectful of size.)
  - Around the stall barns please be respectful of space and **ABSOLUTELY NO PLUGGING TRAILER INTO BARN.**
- Stalls - \$20 per horse per night
