Infraction	Consequence
Fighting	<p>First Offense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$100 Penalty AND • Game suspension (Minimum of one game- may be more depending of severity of incident) AND • Immediate dismissal from premises <p>Second Offense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediate dismissal from premises AND • Indefinite suspension AND • Owner will be fined \$200
<p>Inappropriate Conduct (Aggressive Behavior, Disrespect towards AZDFL staff, Other members of the organization: Owners, Coaches, Players and Team Staff)</p>	<p>First Offense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warning AND • Suspended for the remaining of the game AND • Immediate dismissal from premises <p>Second Offense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dismissal from premises; cannot return until permission is reviewed and granted by AZDFL executive team AND • Owner will be fined \$200
<p>Drugs, Weapons and Alcohol</p>	<p>Not allowed on Premises</p> <p>First Offense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediate dismissal from premises AND • Team Owner must pay \$200 <p>Second Offense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indefinite suspension AND • Team Owner must pay \$500
<p>Authorities may be leveraged to handle any escalated situations as the League must maintain a focus on game operations and attending patrons.</p>	
<p>Dismissal is defined as the “penalized” cannot be within a one-mile radius of the premises (is inclusive of game day field, adjacent school grounds/facilities and parking lot)</p>
