## 1095 Forms Coming Soon!

The 1095 forms will be sent out soon. The forms provide information about your healthcare coverage for 2017.

### Form 1095-A, Health Insurance Marketplace Statement:

The health insurance marketplace (healthcare.gov) sends this form out to individuals who obtained their coverage thru the exchange. The form includes information on the tax credit they received, who was covered and when they had coverage. The marketplace estimates that you will receive this notice no later than mid-February. The forms will also be uploaded to your healthcare.gov account for you to download. This form is needed to file your 2017 tax return.

### Form 1095-B, Health Coverage:

Health insurance companies send this form out to their insureds. This form includes who was covered and when they were covered in 2017. The insurance carriers expect to be sending these forms out within the next few weeks. Most insurers have the form available for download as well on their member portals. You do not need this form to file your taxes.

#### Form 1095-C, Employer-Provided Health Insurance Offer and Coverage:

Some employers will send out this form to their employees covered on their health insurance plan. Generally this form is only sent out by employers that offer "self-insured" coverage. This form provides information on who was covered and when they had coverage. You do not need this form to file your taxes.
