The crew launches into a great adventure where they encounter Brave Crew, led by the incredible Tiger Lily, and Pirates led by the dreaded Captain Hook. 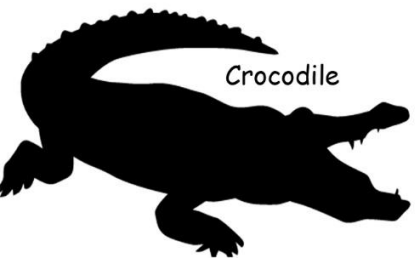

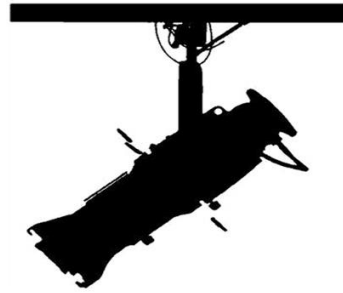
