DRUM POINT COMMUNITY BEACH IS COMMUNITY PROPERTY. It is owned and maintained by the Drum Point Property Owners' Association. The Association can be reached at (410-326-6148). Use of the beach is restricted to Drum Point property owners and their authorized guests.

The Community Beach is located on Beech Drive (Enter Drum Point on Barreda Boulevard, turn left onto Lake Drive, then right onto Huron Drive. Take a left onto Bucker Drive - Buckler Drive will curve sharply to the right and become Mohawk Drive. Turn left onto Beech Drive and proceed to the beach gate on the left.

There are no lifeguards on duty, so **SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK** 

Following are some rules to keep in mind:

- Vehicles must display a Drum Point hang tab.
- No motorized vehicles on beach.
- No littering.
- No open fires.
- No glass containers.
- No pets from May 1 September 30.
- Do not move picnic tables.

If you witness someone bringing their wave runner onto the beach from the water, please call DNR at (410) 260-8888 or (410) 643-8502. Vandalism should be reported to the Calvert County Sheriff's Department at 410-535-2800.
