South Africa Companion Synod receives old Paraments.



This is Pastor Thabani Doma, one of the three visitors from our companion synod, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Southern Africa, who visited Pipestone on October 3rd. They walked the National Monument Trail, talked to the artisans, looked around the visitor's center, and purchased necklaces in the gift shop. They then came to First Lutheran, before going out for supper at the Stonehouse. Several members of First Lutheran and other interested people joined the group for the meal.

Pastor Thabani was absolutely delighted to accept the offer of taking our unused paraments (which the new ones replaced) back to South Africa with them! Pastor Thabani is "modeling" the stoles. There are 2 identical sets of stoles (as when they were purchased, First Lutheran had two pastors), and apparently one of those sets will be given to Bishop Myaka. All of the paraments fit into one suitcase, weighing just under the 50-pound limit and was taken by Pastor Thabani back to South Africa when the group returned on October 12th.

A small group from Southwestern Minnesota will be visiting South Africa in late October and early November, and Pastor Thabani will send something back for us, probably a cross that our acolytes can wear. Pastor Thabani and the other visitors from South Africa were delightful people, and I hope that this connection with our companion synod will grow stronger through the years.

Motivational Short Story of Faith and Hope – Agnostic Man Survives Las Vegas Mass Shooting & Becomes Firm Believer in God

A country music festival in Las Vegas quickly turned tragic when a gunman opened fire on the crowd, killing more than 50 people and injuring hundreds more. When faced with such senseless violence, it's tough to find the good. But Las Vegas shooting survivor Taylor Bengé, who went into the concert agnostic, managed to see not just the good, but the divine. And he came out completely changed.

Sometimes the things that test our faith, can also help grow it. When Las Vegas shooting survivor Taylor Bengé went into the concert on Sunday, October 1, 2017, he didn't really have any faith to speak of. He was pretty much indifferent towards the existence of God.

But as the horrific attack unfolded, something inside Taylor changed.

Light In the Darkness

The gunman's shooting spree — the worst in modern US History — has been labeled by the President an "act of pure evil." And yet, the horror was met with acts of heroism and humanity as the attack unfolded.

"I saw a bunch of people trying to help," Las Vegas shooting survivor Taylor Bengé said. "Unfortunately, I also saw a lot of loved ones with their significant others holding them as they passed."

It's hard to focus on hope when tragedies like the Las Vegas shooting occur. Hearing stories of faith like Taylor's that come out of these situations help us to remember that even in these horrible situations, God has not abandoned us.

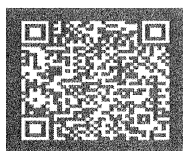

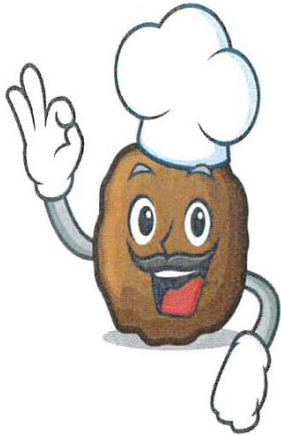
