## **DESCRIPTION**

An ABC Certified Fitter-mastectomy is a health care professional who is specifically educated and trained in the provision of breast prostheses and post-mastectomy items and services. This includes patient assessment, formulation of a treatment plan, implementation of the treatment plan, follow-up and practice management.

The ABC Certified Fitter-mastectomy is bound by the ABC Code of Professional Responsibility which is enforced by a Professional Discipline program.

The time limited certification expires if the certificate holder does not comply with Continuing Education requirements.

## **CRITERIA**

Current eligibility criteria for the ABC Certified Fitter-mastectomy includes:

- A high school diploma, GED or college degree
- Completion of a National Commission on Orthotic and Prosthetic Education (NCOPE) approved mastectomy fitter pre-certification education course
- Completion of 500 hours of mastectomy fitting patient care experience
- Passing score on the written exam
