

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09**

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF LAZY LAKE, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR FULL SERVICE/COUNTY'S PERMIT COUNTER BUILDING CODE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY BROWARD COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFOR.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Lazy Lake ("Village") and Broward County ("County") entered into that certain Interlocal Agreement dated February 27, 2018 ("Agreement"), pursuant to Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, also known as the "Florida Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of 1969" (attached as **Exhibit "A"**), whereby Village procured the services of County for Full Service Building Code Services from the County's Permit Counter for building projects within the municipal boundaries of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement provides for the services to be performed by County through the Building Code Division of the Resilient Environment Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement expired on September 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to retroactively extend its effective date for an additional five (5) year term with a termination date of midnight September 30, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, this First Amendment amends the Agreement accordingly.

**NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAZY LAKE, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The Village Council hereby approves the First Amendment to the Agreement with the County which will extend effective date for an additional five (5) year term with a termination date of midnight September 30, 2027.

**Section 3.** The Mayor is authorized to execute the First Amendment, attached hereto, and deliver the signed First Amendment to the County, for execution.


**Section 4.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or other part of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately after passage by the Village Council and by signature by the Mayor.



DIVISION (f/k/a BUILDING CODE SERVICES DIVISION) OF THE RESILIENT  
ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT (f/k/a ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION  
AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT)

This First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement is made and entered into between: Broward County, a political subdivision of the state of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County,"

and

Village of Lazy Lake, a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the state of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "Village" (collectively referred to as the "Parties").

A. Village and County entered into that certain Interlocal Agreement that was executed by County on February 27, 2018 ("Agreement"), pursuant to Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, also known as the "Florida Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of 1969," whereby Village procured the services of County for Full Service Building Code Services from the County's Permit Counter for building projects within the municipal boundaries of the Village.

B. The Agreement commenced on October 1, 2017, and shall remain in full force and effect until midnight September 30, 2022.

C. The Agreement provides for approval of extensions to the term of the Agreement by the County Administrator.

D. The Parties are desirous of extending the term of the Agreement by one (1) five (5) year period.



Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and representations herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Recitals contained above are true and correct, form a material part of this First Amendment upon which the Parties have relied, and are incorporated by reference.
2. Paragraph 4.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:  
  
4.1. This Agreement shall commence on October 1, 2017, and shall continue in full force and effect until midnight ~~September 30, 2022~~ September 30, 2027.
3. Except as amended herein, all of the terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
4. In the event of any conflict of ambiguity by and between the terms and provisions of this First Amendment and the Agreement, the terms and provisions of this First Amendment shall control to the extent of any such conflict.
5. This First Amendment shall be recorded in the public records of Broward County at Village's expense.


