Day 04	Edfu Kom Ombo	After breakfast, start to Visit ▶ The temple of Edfu, Upper Egyptian site dominated by a large well -Preserved temple, dedicated to the Hawk-God Horus, back to the boat to enjoy the serenity of sailing the river Nile from Edfu to Kom Ombo; in the afternoon visit ▶ Kom Ombo Temple, the double Temple! Such a unique site for its design After that return to the Cruise, relax and enjoy sailing the Nile towards Aswan, dinner & overnight.	Breakfast Lunch Dinner	02 hrs
Day 05	Aswan	Breakfast on Board, then visit ▶Philae Temple, Dedicated to Goddess <i>Isis</i> – The healing wife of <i>Osiris</i> . Moved to the nearby island of Agilkia during the UNESCO Nubia Campaign in the 1960's to rescue sites flooded by the construction of the Aswan High Dam. Then continue to visit ▶The High Dam, one of the biggest infrastructure projects to take place in the 20 th century, taking its importance from being built on the 2 nd longest river in the world – River Nile. After that, return to Cruise, Lunch free afternoon to relax & Overnight.	Breakfast Lunch Dinner	06 hrs
Day 06	Aswan	After breakfast, check out from the Nile Cruise & transfer behind the Dam to embark on <i>M/S Steigenberger Omar El Khayyam</i> , the Lake Nasser Cruise , orientation, dinner & overnight.	Breakfast Lunch Dinner	00 hrs
Day 07	Lake Nasser	After breakfast, visit ► Kalabsha temple, dedicated to Mandulis, the Nubian Sun God similar to the Egyptian Horus. The temple built during the Roman period & moved to make way for the Aswan dam. The next stop is After that visit ► Kiosk of Qertassi, dedicated to Isis, with its main entrance flanked by two columns, presided over by the head of the Goddess Hathor. After return to the Cruise, Dinner & Overnihght.	Breakfast Lunch Dinner	06 hrs
Day 08	Lake Nasser	After breakfast, visit ▶ Wadi El Seboua, Temple of Dakka, and Mehrakka a mixed vibe between rather sadly destroyed & restored Temple Of El Seboua, a wonderful example of Greco-Roman architecture, Temple Of Dakka, ended up being used as a Roman fortress & a very unique feature at Mehrakka Temple, the winding staircase, found nowhere else in Nubian Temples. ▶ Temple of Amada, dedicated to the important New Kingdom gods, Amun-Re and Re-Horakhty followed by ▶ Temple of Derr, dedicated to god Ptah and god Amon, as well as Ramses II as a deified person. Then after return to the Cruise & a relaxing afternoon, dinner & overnight.	Breakfast Lunch Dinner	06 hrs
Day 09	Lake Nasser Abu Simbel	While having Breakfast, cruise will be sailing towards Kasr Ibrahim ► Kasr Ibrahim was an economic, political, and religious center in Nubia & is the only major archaeological site in Lower Nubia to have survived the Nile floods. The island is off limits to visitors so Tour will be from the Cruise Deck. After continue to visit ► Abu Simbel, Built during the reign of the great Pharaoh Rameses II & dedicated to him and the gods Amun, Ra-Horakhty, and Ptah. The temple moved from its original place & reassembled during the construction of the High Dam to a higher level to save it from being flooded with water. Return to the Cruise, dinner & overnight.	Breakfast Lunch Dinner	13 hrs
Day 10	Cairo	After breakfast, check out from the cruise & transfer to Aswan Airport for domestic flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, meet & greet then transfer to your hotel, check in, Dinner & overnight.	Breakfast Dinner	00 hrs
Day 11	Cairo	After breakfast, meet your Guide at the lobby to start your day. You will visit ▶ Giza Plateau. Experience standing at <i>Cheops, the great pyramid</i> – the biggest in the world, <i>Chephren & Mycerinus</i> Pyramids.
