Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487

Bylaw No. 9-2013

## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a) "Designated officer" shall mean
    - i) the person appointed as the Administrator of the municipality; or
    - ii) the person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
  - b) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487;
  - c) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487.
2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Municipality, in a financial institution designated by Council, all cash moneys collected and received when they have accumulated to the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).
3. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but in any case, not less than once a month nor more than once each day.
