

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIPAWIN NO. 487

BYLAW NO 15-2016

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw;
 - a) “firearm” means a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, projectiles or any other thing by means of an explosive, excluding tools designed and certified for construction purposes;
 - b) “Country Residential Subdivision” means any area which under the provisions of the Zoning Bylaw is zoned Country Residential;
 - c) “Hamlet” means any area which under the provisions of the Zoning Bylaw is zoned Hamlet;
 - d) “Resort Residential Subdivision” means any area which under the provisions of the Zoning Bylaw is zoned Resort Residential; and
 - e) “Zoning Bylaw” means the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 Zoning Bylaw.
2. Subject to Section 3 hereof, no person shall discharge any firearm out of doors within the following areas of this Municipality or within five hundred (500) metres of such areas:
 - a) a Country Residential Subdivision;
 - b) a Hamlet; or
 - c) a Resort Residential Subdivision.
3. This bylaw shall not apply:
 - a) to any person having authority under a statute of Canada or Saskatchewan to have in his possession a firearm when such firearm is discharged under the authority, and within the scope, of that person’s duty;
 - b) A person authorized by the municipality to discharge firearms.

4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this Municipality.

5. Bylaw No. 8-2015 is hereby repealed.




