- CALL TO ORDER** Pete Coppins called the Historical Preservation Commission meeting to order at 6:01pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

- OLD BUSINESS** **315 Center Street – Historic Designation**
OTHER Pete Coppins asked if there is anyone here representing 315 Center St. Architect David Giusiana stated that owner Herb Richardson is still pursuing subdividing the lot. Coppins said we gave the owner three months which brings us to tonight’s meeting and we are going to take a vote on designating the home, the building itself, at 315 Center St.
- A motion was made by Chris O’Hara seconded by Jim Fittante and passed unanimously to historically designate the building itself, at 315 Center St.
- NEW BUSINESS** **890 Center Street – Sunoco / A Plus – Sign Application**
A representative from Pro Signs explained the stand alone sign is the exact same size sign. We are changing out the inserts to have two sets of digital numbers and Sunoco will be the same as existing sign. The A Plus is just an image upgrade which is the same on the pumps. The A Plus building sign is actually 15sq ft smaller than the previous sign.
- A motion was made by Jim Fittante seconded by Chris O’Hara and passed unanimously to accept the Sunoco / A Plus sign application at 890 Center St. as presented.
