The presentation spent a lot of time on the various uses of YouTube. It has videos on just about anything (many of the links provided are from YouTube), 37 million channels for specific interests, how to videos on almost any subject and a great deal of free entertainment. It also has one of the best paid live streaming services which we cover in the presentation. Before deciding whether to cut-the-cord go to Youtube.com and look at the various features it provides as well as the informative videos on streaming. To start, Go to the "How to use YouTube" video.

Section 1 on the Internet contained a brief description of how the Internet works with two main points; 1)Each device has a unique internet address and when you are using the internet, if you do not use a VPN (see link in security section), anyone can see where you are and can "learn" a great deal about you and, 2) If you are going to stream you need an absolute minimum of 5mbs per second speed and high speed connection are important.

Section 2 discussed security and the value of VPNs, Good passwords, Paying with PayPal and included security tip videos.

CHANNEL COMPARISON FOR THE MAIN PROVIDERS:

This works great in major markets (40-60 CHANNELS) but may not provide many channels in rural areas. One time cost under \$50 makes this something worth trying if your goal is to get local live channels. A bit more info on this option:

- MORE CHANNELS ARE BEEN ADDED EVERYDAY
- This one has great reviews-CHANNEL MASTER FLATENA 35 OR DUO-(\$25 purchase)
- LIMITATIONS IS YOU NEED ONE FOR EACH TV AND IT DOES NOT WORK ON PC/PHONE (IT NEEDS A TV AS REQUIRES A TUNER)
- FOR CHANNEL AVAILABILITY IN YOUR AREA- <u>www.rabbitears.info</u>

- PAID SERVICES-NETFLIX, AMAZON AND MANY OTHERS ARE GREAT ADD-ONS
- CHEAPEST LIVE OPTION-INDOOR HD TV ANTENNA
- A LOW-COST CHOICE IS HD TV ANTENNA + A PAID SERVICE THAT MEETS YOUR NEEDS (EXAMPLE NETFLIX OR AMAZON PRIME)
