Angelic beings

bene elohim

- 1. Angelic beings were given dominion over the heavens (Genesis 1:14-19).
- 2. (Genésis 6: 1-4) Some rebellious angelic beings had sexual relations with women and produced the nephilim.
- 3. (Job 1) The sons of God were in heaven and the Satan was among them
- 4. (1 Kings 22: 19-22) the sons of God make up the divine council.



Adam

The first man

- 1. Adam and his descendants were given dominion over the earth (Genesis 1:28)
- 2. Luke 3: 38 Adam is called the "son of God."
- 3. Jewish literature presents Adam as a glorious being who amazed the angels until he sinned and was removed from the garden of Eden. Consequently; man is a little lower than the angels.





Jesus Christ

The God-man


- 1. Jesus Christ is the only begotten (unique) Son of God (John 3:18)
- 2. Jesus Christ is both fully God and fully man.
- 3. Jesus Christ is referred to as the Son of God at least 26 times in the New Testament.
- 4. Jesus Christ only referred to himself as the Son of God 5 times (John 3:18, 5:25, 9: 35, 10:36, 11:4).



The Kingdom of God

Abraham's seed

- 1. Abraham's seed are the sons of God (Romans 4:16, 9: 6-8)
- 2. Man is a little lower than the angels (Psalms 8:3-8)
- 3. Believers will be the sons of God (Romans 8:14-16)
- 4. Believers will be like the angels (Matthew 22:30).
- 5. Believers will be equal to the angels (Luke 20: 4-36)
- 6. Believers will becomes the sons of God (John 1:12).
- 7. Believers will judge the angels (1 Corinthians 6:3)
- 8. Sons of God have the Holy Spirit (Galatians 4: 6-7)





Sons of God and the stars

Men and Angels

- 1. Angelic beings are related to the stars of Heaven (Psalms 147:4, Isaiah 40:26).
- 2. Abraham's seed will be as the stars of heaven (Genesis 15:5)
- 3. Christians are part of Abraham's seed (Roman's 4:16)
- 4. Abraham's seed will have celestial (star) bodies in the resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:35-49)
- 5. Jesus Christ is the bright morning star (Revelation 22:16)
