Ezekiel was a prophet and priest who obeyed the will of God. He was referred to as the "son of man," 97 times. Ezekiel was also a contemporary of Daniel, the prophet, in Babylon. Daniel is called "son of man" only once (Daniel 8:17).

DANIEL 7:13-14 AND THE SON OF MAN

I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before Him. And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.





EZEKIEL AND JESUS CHRIST

- 1. Both Ezekiel and Jesus Christ obeyed the will of God.
- 2. Both are priests and prophets.
- 3. Both warned that God would destroy Jerusalem (Eze 1-24; Mat 24).
- 4. Ezekiel mentions the "Prince," who is Jesus Christ (Eze 34:24).
- 5. Both point to the restoration of Jerusalem (Eze 33-48; Rev 21-22).

JESUS CHRIST: THE SON OF MAN

- 1. Jesus Christ most often referred to himself as the "Son of Man."
- 2. Jesus Christ only referred to himself as the Son of God three times.
- 3. Jesus Christ returned to heaven with the clouds (Acts 1:8-11).
- 4. The Son of Man is by the right hand of the Father (Acts 7:56).
- 5. Jesus Christ will return with the clouds (1 Thess 4:13-17).
- 6. Jesus Christ, the Son of Man, will harvest the earth (Rev 14:14).
