Under the supervision of the Program Manager, the primary goal of the Youth Transition Coordinator is assisting persons with disabilities aged 14–24 to reach consumer-driven goals related to enhancing, improving or maintaining their independence through the provision of programs offered at the CIL and connecting youth to community services. The Youth Transition Coordinator facilitates educational workshops aimed at improving, reducing, or eliminating societal stigmas about disability with the purpose of empowering consumers and cultivating a new generation of life-long advocates. The Youth Transition Coordinator must have vast knowledge of college-related resources, vocational programs available locally and youth-related services offered locally and nationally. The Youth Transition Coordinator performs various duties in support of Access to Independence mission and may also have unique duties and responsibilities associated with a particular grant.

Qualifications:

- High School graduate and lived experience, preferred, or;
- Associate's or Bachelor's degree in a related field with a combination of lived experience
- Peer-to-peer experience
- Bilingual, American Sign Language certified; preferred but not required



ENERGY SAVINGS FOR RENTERS AND HOMEOWNERS

To help its customers keep their energy costs down, SDG&E launched a new program for renters and owners of single-family homes. The Residential Energy Solutions (RES) program has no income restrictions. Eligible customers receive no-cost upgrades such as smart thermostats, low-flow showerheads, brushless fan motors, HVAC services like air duct testing and sealing – and more. SDG&E has contracted with Synergy Companies to provide customers with energy efficiency audits from their experts. Customers can request a home visit at sdge.com/RES or by calling (888)272-8394.

SDG&E offers other assistance programs, too:

- <u>Neighbor-to-Neighbor</u> customers may receive up to \$600 toward their past due energy bill
- <u>CARE</u> customers can save 30% or more off their energy bill
- FERA customers can receive an 18% discount on their electricity bill
- <u>ESA</u> no-cost energy-efficiency upgrades to income-qualified customers
- <u>Golden States Rebates</u> program incentives of \$20 \$500 to buy high-efficiency water heaters, smart thermostats or room air conditioners
- <u>Arrearage Management Payment (AMP) Plan</u> debt forgiveness for past due bills for CARE and FERA customers
