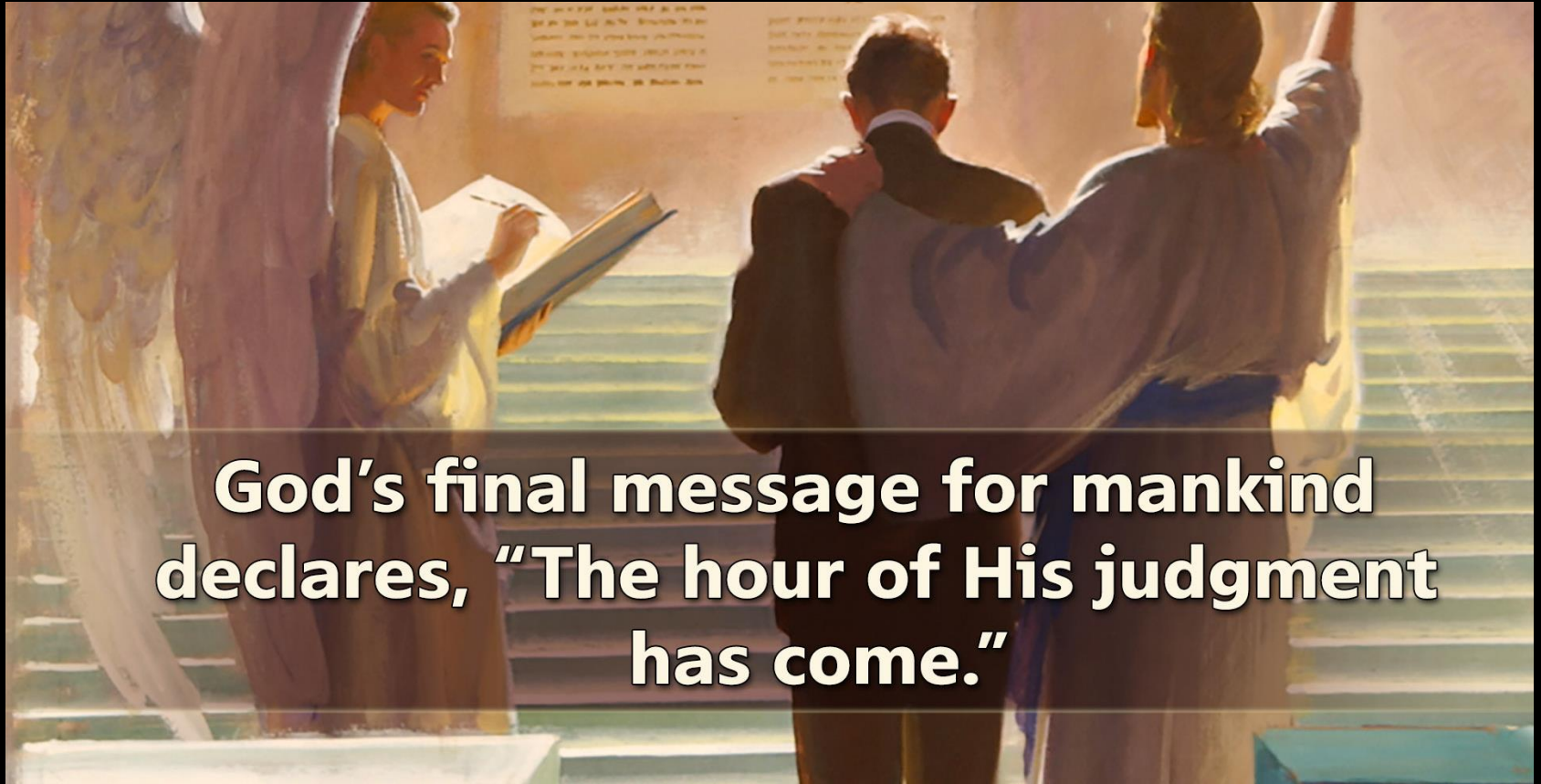


How do we give glory to God?

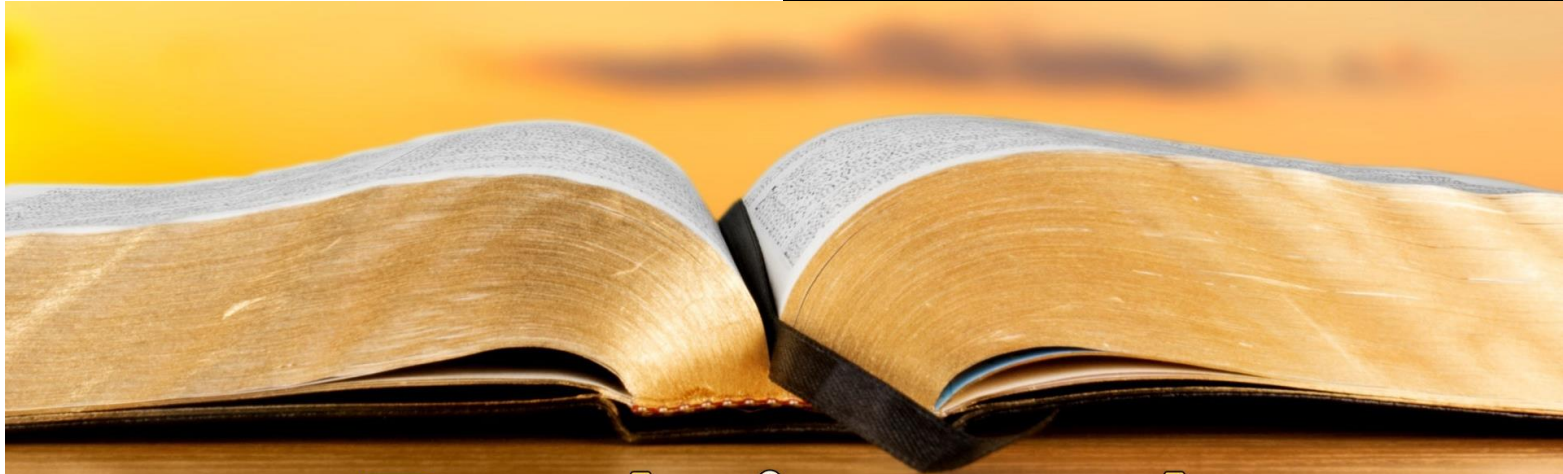
