Realm #1

Head of Gold
Babylon
609 BC to 539 BC

Realm #2

Breast & Arms of Silver
Medo Persia
539 BC to 331 BC

Realm #3

Thighs of Brass
Greece
331 BC to 168 BC

Realm #4

Legs of Iron
Rome
168 BC to Second Coming

Feet & Toes of Iron & Clay
Divided Rome with a mixing of church/state
486 AD to Second Coming

Realm #5

Stone/Mountain
Christ's Kingdom
Second Coming to Eternity

BOOKS OF NT

27 Books (New 3) x (Testament 9) = 27

The OT covered a period of about 3600 years, The NT covers a period of about 100 years.

Just like the OT the NT isn't written in Chronological order, but there is a rhyme and a reason why the books are organized the way they are.

5 Historical (4 Gospels and Acts)

13 Letters from Paul

- 9 to Churches (Longest to Shortest)
- 4 to Individuals (Longest to Shortest)

8 other Letters (Longest to Shortest & By Author)
