Fun facts:

- Evan Rachel Wood broke the capillaries around her eyes while filming an intensely emotional scene.
- Elliot Page was inspired to make the film (credited as producer), after coming across the book written by Jean Hegland. They were browsing a bookshop in their native Canada, and the shop owner recommended it.
- Elliot and Evan spent a great deal of time together away from filming, in order to make their onscreen sibling relationship seem authentic. Elliot explained that they did experience a true and genuine deep connection.
- Eva and Nell were chosen as shortened derivatives of the actors' real names.
- The pig butchering scene was real, and Page learned the process to ensure authenticity in the scene. They stated that they found the process difficult and upsetting.
- In the film, the house begins to decay and is eventually burned down. In actuality, the crew and production designer (Jeremy Stanbridge) were able to achieve those visuals without damaging the modern architecture by the architect Frederick Hollingsworth.
